## **SERMON QUESTIONS**

Adventures of Saint Paul

Acts 13:1-6a

The Lord called Paul, his first missionary . . . "This man is my chosen instrument to proclaim my name to the Gentiles and their kings and to the people of Israel. I will show him how much he must suffer for my name." (Acts 9:15-16).

The missionary call has not changed since Paul. Suffering for His name is the missionary call.

- 1. Question: Have you ever been on a mission trip? Share where you went, what you did, how you felt about it. What hardships did you endure?
- 2. Backing up to Acts 10-12, what was God doing in his people through Peter to set the stage for Saul's/Paul's first Missionary Journey?
- 3. Read Acts 13: 1-6a. Describe the church which was at Antioch. Dr. Mary Ho describes it as:
  - a) Worshiping and Holy Spirit Sending Church: Question: What evidence is there of this at Sunset Church?
  - b) A Suffering Church: Read Acts 11: 19-21 Question: What were the consequences of the persecution in Rome? How did it further the reach of the Gospel?
  - c) A Discipling Church: Read Acts 11: 22-26 Question: How have you been disciple? where do you see this happening at Sunset Church?
  - d) A Giving Church: Read Acts 11:27-30 Question: Where do our tithes and offerings go at Sunset? What fruit has Giving produced in your life?
  - e) **A Diverse Church**: Read Acts 13:1-2 Question: Describe the variety of people in the church at Antioch. What diversity is there at Sunset?
  - f) An Innovative Church: What were some of the innovative practices of the Antioch church which Mary mentioned? What creative innovations have you seen at Sunset Church?
- 4. Pray for our church here at Sunset; for its leaders, ministries, and outreach. Pray for other churches in our area.
