

SUNSET CHURCH WORSHIP MINISTRY INTERNSHIP

POSITION TITLE: Worship Intern

REPORTS TO: Phil Church, Worship & Creative Arts Minister

STATUS: Unpaid (~20 hours/week, fundraising encouraged)

PHILOSOPHY

Sunset Church is a community of people, connected to each other and committed to making disciples of all the nations – who are becoming transformed into the likeness of Christ. Interns must be committed to Jesus Christ and the work Christ is doing at Sunset Church, along with being in agreement with these values. The person in this position is expected to have spiritual integrity as well as loyalty and commitment to the staff and congregation of Sunset Church.

POSITION SUMMARY

The Worship Intern will spend their time working with the Worship & Creative Arts Minister, Worship Team Program Director, Technical Arts Director, and other worship/tech staff to plan, set up, coordinate, implement, and facilitate weekly worship services. Training will be provided to support volunteers, creatively plan service as well as incorporate creative elements to the worship experience. An intern may be challenged to compose original music, expand on musical gifting, and gain leadership skills used to facilitate worship in a congregational setting.

The Sunset Worship Intern will work ~20/week with a focus in worship ministries. In addition, there will be required reading and time with the intern cohort – encouraging personal, spiritual, and leadership growth, along with discerning vocational calling.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Collaborating in crafting worship services
 - Song selection (i.e., keys, tempo, pastoral collaboration, scripture references, etc.)
 - Sermon series consideration - (i.e., taking into consideration the positioning of the service within a larger sermon series and how song selection/introducing new songs effects other things)
- Planning Center (e.g., scheduling, volunteer communication)
- Cultivate community with volunteers
- Sourcing and Uploading charts/creating new chord charts and lead sheets if needed
- Learn Technical aspects (e.g., front of house sound, lights, cameras, streaming, etc.)
- Writing songs/original music (if there is a gifting there)
 - Writing, Recording, Producing, Releasing, Teaching/Implementing in Worship Services
