We are so excited for Night to Shine and have some wonderful things planned for you! Here are some details to help you feel prepared for the prom.

What to wear

The prom is a formal event, so it is an opportunity for you to wear your best clothes, but we also want you to be comfortable. Formal wear is not required.

Event Schedule

5:30 pm - 6:30 pm: Check in and optional makeup, hair, and shoeshine

6 pm: The Prom officially starts! Here are things you can do:

- Dance with your friends
- Enjoy dinner and dessert
- Visit the karaoke room and sing a song\
- Get your picture taken with fun props
- Visit the sensory room if you are feeling overwhelmed and need a break

9 pm: End of Prom

Who can join me (the guest) at Night to Shine?

A maximum of three people can join you at the event. Up to two people can enjoy the Respite Room and one person can join you as a buddy.

Every guest attending Night to Shine is required to have a buddy, a buddy is a companion who will stay by your side throughout the entire evening to help make sure you have the most enjoyable night possible.

There are two ways to be paired with a buddy:

- 1. We can provide you with a buddy when you arrive at the event.
- 2. You may bring your own buddy (friend, relative, parent, or caregiver).

Note: Your buddy cannot be another registered guest. A buddy does not use the respite room and stays with you for the entire evening. If you bring your own buddy, they must register as a preferred buddy.

In addition to the buddy, each guest is allowed to have up to two family members/caregivers come to the event and enjoy the respite room. A family member/caregiver can stay with their guest as a buddy through the entirety of the event OR may take advantage of the Respite Room, they may not do both. The respite room is a space set aside for family members/caregivers to enjoy food, connect with other families and rest while remaining onsite during the event.
